Abstract

This study examines the process of institutionalization as it has occurred for the Scholarly Publishing Services Program (SPSP), an evolution of the library publishing activities at the University of Anywhere. As an innovation which challenges many of the conventions of library-based publishing, it is necessary to approach the evaluation of SPSP with a concern for appropriate methods and a consideration of issues of legitimacy in the institutional environment. A method for differentiating innovation and convention through an examination of core "exemplars" is developed. This analysis then provides a basis for recasting evaluation as a political process where innovative programs struggle to maintain those exemplars which make them different while achieving the legitimacy which makes them possible.

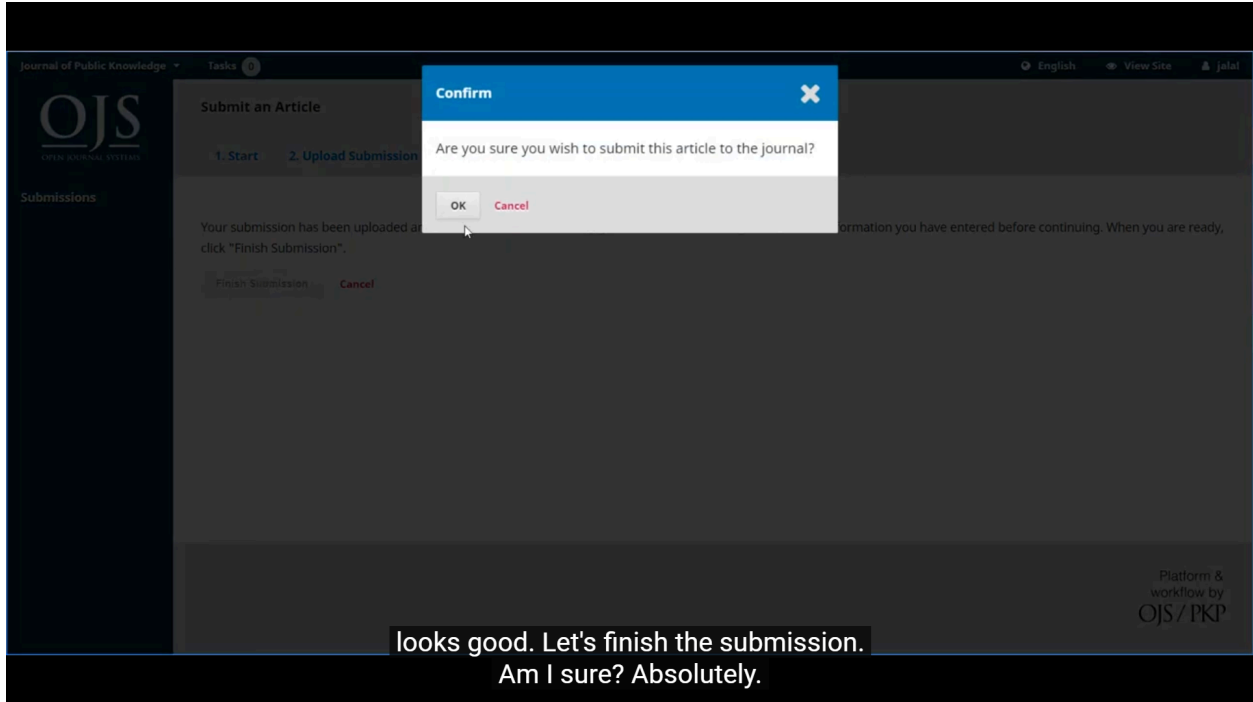

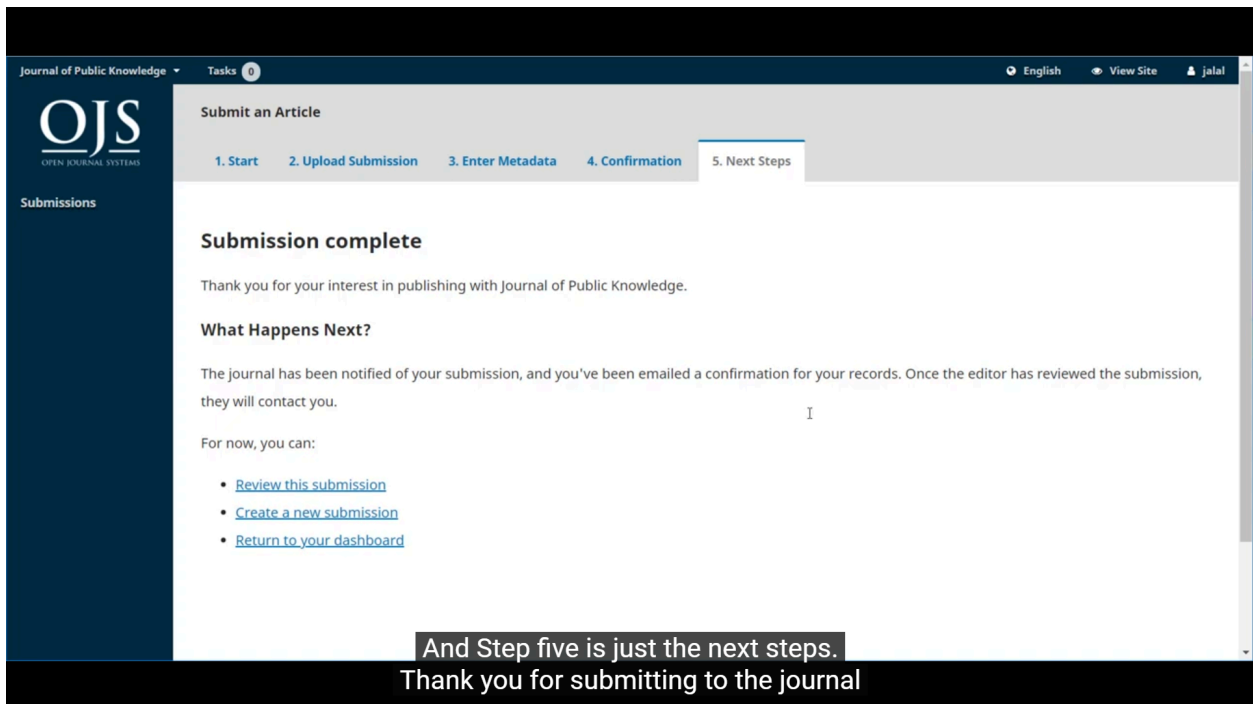
